

GREENLEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CLIFTON, ARIZONA

May 19, 2010

The Greenlee County Board of Supervisors met on this date in Special session in the Board Meeting Room, 2nd floor Courthouse Annex, Clifton, Arizona, with the following members present: Hector Ruedas, Chairman; Richard Lunt, Member; and David Gomez, Member. Also present were Deborah K. Gale, County Administrator, and Yvonne Pearson, Clerk of the Board.

The Board convened into Work Session with the Apache-Sitgreaves (A-S) Forest Supervisor Chris Knopp for discussion and update on the A-S Forest Plan Revision and other National Forest issues.

Mr. Knopp addressed the following regarding the Forest Plan Revision:

- Environmental Impact Statement changes
- Proposed wild and scenic rivers will be removed from the map as they are not part of the management
- The completion of the Plan has been delayed due to non-performance of the contractor who has been terminated.
- A purpose of the Travel Management Plan is to prevent cross-country travel - prevent unauthorized creation of roads
- It has been discovered that 20% of existing roads are not in the database.
- Approximately 150 miles of road will be closed primarily due to archaeological sites

The Board expressed the importance of communication with the County for the ability to keep issues within the County addressed.

Mr. Knopp will meet with the Board again in July.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:36 a.m.
