

POSTING OF POLITICAL SIGNS IN GREENLEE COUNTY

Political signs may be posted only with the prior approval of the Property Owner. Contact the Greenlee County Assessor for assistance in determining the ownership of property before posting signs in any location.

No sign may be placed along a State highway right-of-way without the permission of the Arizona Department of Transportation. For US Highway 191, the phone number for the local ADOT office in Safford is 1-928-428-5470.

Remember that law requires a Blue Stake Permit before digging on public or private property. Call the Arizona Blue Stake Center at 1-800-782-5348 for further information.

POSTING OF POLITICAL SIGNS ON FREEPORT-MCMORAN (FMI) COPPER & GOLD PROPERTY

APPROVED LOCATION: On the east berm of FMI Lot 2 at the East Plantsite turnoff. Signs reading ■POLITICAL SIGNS MAY BE PLACED BETWEEN SIGNS• have been placed to designate the area along the berm where signs can be placed. Signs must be placed on/in the raised portion of the berm. Signs may not be placed anywhere else at this site than on/in the raised portion of the berm. Signs may not be placed between the high-pressure natural gas signs or within five (5) feet of the natural gas line warning signs.

Other Guidelines/Conditions/Restrictions:

- All signs/posters must have the name, address and telephone number of the responsible person/party written on or firmly attached to the back of the sign.
- All signs/posters must be removed within seven (7) days following subject election date. Removal includes the clean-up of all nails, wire, tape, stakes, posts or other materials used to erect the signs/posters.
- Signs/posters will be placed with courtesy and respect for other individual*s/parties* political signage.
- No signs/posters may be placed on or along any street, road or public thoroughfare of the Morenci Townsite.
- No signs/posters may be placed within any public use area of the Morenci Plaza and Morenci Townsite.
- No signs/posters may be placed within or outside the offices or businesses of FMI or its subsidiaries, the Morenci Water & Electric Company and the FMI Mercantile Company.
- Signs/posters placed within the business space of a commercial lessee of FMI property requires the consent of the business owner of record.
- Signs/posters placed within the yard or home of a residential lessee of FMI property requires the consent of the resident and lessee of record.

Miscellaneous Info:

- _ Both the federal and state law require an individual, public utility or contractor to obtain a Blue Stake Permit prior to any excavation or penetration of public or private property. Phone number for the Arizona Blue Stake Center is 1-800-782-5348.
- _ No sign may be placed along a State highway right-of-way without the permission of the Arizona Department of Transportation. For US Highway 191, the phone number for the local ADOT office in Safford is 1-928-428-5470.
