Rodeo Dates: April 1, 2011, June 25, July 30 and August 27 (Changes will be mailed)

Rodeo Time: 4:00pm

Onsite entering: 2:30-3:30/Start 4:00pm (No entries accepted after 3:30)

Entry by mail: Down load form from website and mail to above address with entry fees (postmarked 5 days before event).

Finals on September 16, 2011 at 6:00pm (Will receive form by mail to qualified contestants, see below)

Any event cancelled due to rain or other will be rescheduled.

Rules and General Information

To be eligible for the finals to be held at the Greenlee County Fair, contestants must have attended at least three of the series rodeos held in April, June, July & August to be eligible. During the finals, contestants will only be able to enter events that he or she participates in (3 of 4) during the series. Points will be tallied after the finals for year end awards and awards will be presented on Saturday, September 17 at 6:00pm before the Grand Canyon Pro Rodeo. Points will only be awarded for events that are entered a minimum of 3 times. (Example: You were in the barrels and goat tying for all year, then on the 4th rodeo you entered the pole bending. You will only receive points for the barrels and goat tying and not the pole bending. You may enter other events for the competition and payback but will not receive points.)

Breakaway, Goat Tying, Team Roping & Jr/Sr Team Roping

Sheep & Calf Riding (6 seconds, 1 or 2 hands)

The following will be paid less stock fee. Places will be paid no matter the amount of qualified rides. If the child is held on by an adult, he/she will receive a no time.

Steer Riding (8 seconds, 1 hand only)

The following will be paid less stock fee. Places will be paid only on qualified rides. If no qualified rides are made, pay outs will be paid to the highest times according to the rate below less stock fee.

Barrels, Flags, Poles, Goat Tying, Breakaway & Team Roping

If a no time is received or he/she places beyond 10th place you will receive 1 point. Team Ropers will only receive points for your best out of 3 if you enter 3 times.

Calf & Sheep riding

Points will go toward the rides that receive a score, skip 2 placings, then to the next highest time under 6 seconds. If 6 seconds are not reach by any rider, points will be distributed starting with the longest time then on down. If a child is held on by an adult he/she will receive 1 point only.

Steer Riding

Points will go toward the rides that receive a score. A no score will receive 1 point. If no qualified ride is made, points will go to the highest times.

Please be ready when your name is called.

Tie

In the event of a tie, the points for each place will be added together and divided by the number of contestants tying. If there is a tie in points for year end awards, the contestant with the highest total payout will receive the award.

If there is a discrepancy, the Junior Rodeo Series committee will make the final decisions.
